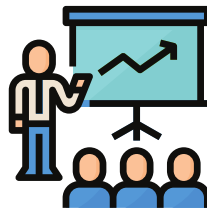
Community Social Enterprise – Small Business Capital

What it is all about

To provide start-up capital up to RM10,000 based on the business proposal.

Who can apply

- Minimum of 3 people in a group who are interested to start small business.
- Must be people who are fall in the categories: B40 group and priority given to Single Mother, Orphan, OKU, Senior Citizen, Indian community, Fisherman, Indigenous community, former prisoners/juveniles and military/police retiree.



Capacity Building

What it is all about

To provide assistance to targeted groups to overcome the barrier that can hinder their participation in that economic activities and generate income by providing:

- Short Course and Skills that leads to Entrepreneurship for 3 months.
- Short Course and Skills that leads to Employment for 3 months and 6 month incentive to Employers.

Who can apply

All B40 group in Iskandar Malaysia. Priority given to nine (9) targeted group : Single Mother, Orphan, OKU, Senior Citizen, Indian community, Fisherman, Indigenous community, former prisoners/juveniles and military/police retiree.



IM Makmur Fund

What it is all about

Fund up to RM20,000 to lead, coordinate and conduct socio-economy activities to minimum of 20 people from targeted group.

Who can apply

Any entity including Non-Governmental Organisations (NGO) in Iskandar Malaysia.

What is all about

Matching grant to a maximum of RM150,000.

Who Can Apply

- Open to Malaysian aged 18-40 year old residing and operating business in Iskandar Malaysia.
- Open for new business only.
- Applicant must be part of top management in the said business.
- Interested and have potential in business.
- Business in truck.

What is the scope of the grant

- Purchase of vehicle.
- Machinery and equipment.



Shared Business Facilities

What is it all about

Matching grant to a maximum of RM125,000.

Who Can Apply

- Open to Malaysian aged 18-40 year old residing and operating business in Iskandar Malaysia.
- Open for new business only.
- Applicant must be part of top management in the said business.
- Interested and have potential in business.
- Minimum of 5 SMEs running businesses under one roof.

What is the scope of the grant

- Renovation cost.
- Rental – up to 3 months @ 15 percent of total maximum grant approved whichever is lower.

What is it all about

Assists the targeted group in gaining employment with high paying jobs in a rapidly expanding economic corridor through 50:50 salary matching grant, eligible to apply up to RM2000 per employee for 6 months.

Who can apply

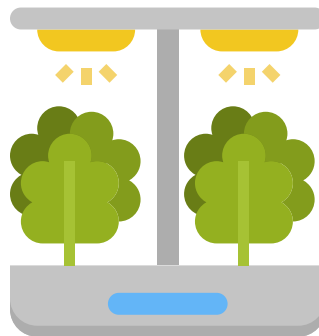
- Employers who retain workers during pandemic Covid19 starting from January 2020. Employer new hiring starting from March 2020 onwards.
- Employers should have registered with the Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM).
- Employees must be earning RM4,000 or less (Executive Level and above).
- Local employees ONLY.

Iskandar Malaysia Urban Farming (IMURFARM) 2.0



What is it all about

Iskandar Malaysia Urban Farming (IMURFARM) 2.0 – Kebun Bandar is a grant for low income community in urban areas to carry out urban farming project with the objective of earning income through high-yield crops or urban and modern agriculture practices.

Who can apply

- B40 and M40 between the age of 18-40 years old.
- Retrenched workers/Unemployed Graduates.
- Have agriculture background / experience / interest.
- Willing to sign 2-year contract with IRDA.
- Willing to provide full commitment and have plans to become an entrepreneur in food and agro.

How long is the duration of the programme

Minimum 2 years.

What models of farming are involved

- Outdoor Integrated Farming System – Fertigation, NFT and Madu Kelulut.
- Indoor Farming System – Vegetable / Mushroom.
- Indoor Farming System with IOT Solutions.
